

Fontana ECS Membership

Membership in Fontana ECS carries with it a personal commitment to public service. This commitment is extremely important in preparing for, responding to and recovering from all types of emergencies.

(A) To become a member of the Fontana ECS organization, the applicant must:

- 1. Be 21 years of age
- 2. Be a licensed amateur radio operator
- 3. Work well in a team environment
- 4. Have a desire to provide emergency communications services
- 5. Attend three consecutively scheduled meetings
- 6. Must have a valid California Driver's License
- 7. Possess current Automobile Insurance
- 8. Complete an application
- 9. Pass a volunteer oral interview
- 10. Submit to an abbreviated background check by the City of Fontana

(B) To be a Member in Good Standing status:

- 1. Be sworn in as a Disaster Service Worker
- 2. Wear proper OES Volunteer Uniform and ID Badge for appropriate activities
- 3. Attend at least 6 monthly meetings per year
- 4. Participate in 10 hours of training activities per month
- 5. Check into at least 2 radio nets per month
