





- Fireworks should only be used by adults
- Sparklers can reach 1800 degrees, hot enough to melt gold
- Always have a bucket of water or a water hose near by
- Always make sure you are away from combustible sources
- Only use approved "Safe and Sane" fireworks that have a seal from the State Fire Marshal on the package
- Unincorporated areas of the County DO NOT allow any fireworks, so check to see if your neighborhood is within the City limits
- Visit sbcfire.org for updated information regarding fireworks

When you're outside enjoying the day make SAFETY a priority:

- Wear helmets for any wheeled piece of equipment: bikes, scooters, in-line blades, skates, etc.
- Assign someone to be a "Water Watcher" when kids are in/near water.
- Know basic CPR and First Aid, it could save your life. Many children and adults can choke on the smallest items (hot dog, nuts, candy, etc.), knowing how to identify someone that is choking and the Heimlich is a life saving measure.




THINK BEFORE FLUSHING!

Toilets and sewer systems are designed to transport and dispose of three things: water, toilet paper, and human waste. Recently, the prime culprits in clogging sewer systems have been "flushable" products. Contrary to their name, these products should not be flushed.

Items that should never be flushed:

- "Flushable items" (wipes, toilet bowl scrub pads, disposable mops, diapers)
- Tampons, tampon applicators, sanitary napkins, condoms
- Medications, vitamins & supplements
- Fats, oils & grease
- Food items (bones, apple cores, coffee grounds, nutshells)
- Paper towels, napkins, facial tissues
- Disposable diapers & baby wipes
- Wash rags, cloth, clothing
- Kitty litter, aquarium gravel, bedding material for animals such as hamsters
- Pet waste & pet waste bags
- Plastic (of any kind)
- Cotton swabs and balls, bandages
- Dental floss
- Chewing gum
- Cosmetics
- Pets (goldfish, hamsters, gerbils)
- Hair
- Syringes
- Poisons & hazardous waste

Most of these listed items can be discarded in the trash, though there are some that have more specific disposal methods. For information regarding disposal and recycling options of the materials listed, call 350-6760.

- Moderates soil temperature
- Prevents Compaction
- Adds organic matter
- Slows evaporation
- Reduces erosion



PAYMENT & FEES

- The following are accepted as a form of registration payment: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Check or Money Orders. For security purposes, identification will be asked to be provided for credit cards and check payments.
- All fees, times and dates of all programs are subject to change.
- An additional \$12 non-resident fee applies per participant, per class, per activity or membership. A non-resident is anyone living outside the incorporated boundaries of the City of Fontana.
- All checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$25 administration fee, in addition to the class fee. The total fee will need to be paid in cash or money order at Fontana City Hall.
- A \$2 administrative fee applies to all transactions.

REFUND/CREDIT/TRANSFER POLICY

If you are unable to attend or are not satisfied with a class, you may transfer to another class (if space is available), process a credit within the Community Services Department for future program registration or process a request for refund. Requests for refunds must be made prior to the second class meeting.
