Stormwater pollution prevention

Help prevent stormwater pollution. Keeping our streets and gutters free of trash, oil, paint and other pollutants protects our water. Tips to reduce stormwater pollution:

- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean your paved driveway, sidewalks and streets.
- Wash your car where the water and soap won't flow to the street.
- Avoid using pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers when possible. If you must use yard chemicals, apply only as directed and never before a storm.







HOLIDAY SAFETY

Halloween

- Make sure costumes are flame retardant & masks do not obstruct vision.
- Make sure everyone carries a flashlight.
- Be careful when walking/crossing streets.

Thanksgiving

- Cooking fires are the number one cause of home fires and injuries.
- Have a 3' kids free zone around hot things in the kitchen.
- Put a lid on grease fires.
- Make sure pot holders, towels, etc. are kept away from heat sources.

Christmas

- Check all electrical cords/lights to make sure they are listed for indoor or outdoor use, and check for frays or cracks in the cords and make sure they're not placed under rugs or furniture.
- Make sure live trees have plenty of water and are flame retardant. Never put lights on a metal tree. Always put your live tree on the curb for recycling - never place in the fireplace.
- Make sure candles are on a solid surface. Never put them on a tree.
- Never block an exit with a tree or other decoration.
- Make sure everyone in the home knows the family escape plan.
- Make sure gifts/toys are not on a recall list (visit CPSC.gov for list).

DISASTER PREPAREDNESS TIPS

Kitchen Safety

- Never leave items cooking unattended.
- Wear tight fitted sleeves to avoid contact with flames.
- Put a lid on grease fires (take away oxygen).
- Move handles of pots/pans out of reach.

Fire Extinguishers

- Fire extinguishers are for small fires.
- Make sure you have the proper extinguisher for the type of fire.
- Never block your exits and know where other extinguishers are located.
- Call 911 for any fire and evacuate.

Hunt for Home Hazards

- Extension cords, combustibles near a heat source (needs 3' space).
- Medicines and household cleaners can be poisonous.

Heating Safety

- Have all your heating equipment checked as well as your fireplace.
- Carbon Monoxide is a silent killer that can result from faulty equipment.

THINK BEFORE FLUSHING!

Toilets and sewer systems are designed to transport and dispose of three things: water, toilet paper, and human waste. Recently, the prime culprits in clogging sewer systems have been "flushable" products. Contrary to their name, these products should not be flushed.

Items that should never be flushed:

- "Flushable items" (wipes, toilet bowl scrub pads, disposable mops, diapers)
- Tampons, tampon applicators, sanitary napkins, condoms
- Medications, vitamins & supplements
- Fats, oils & grease
- Food items (bones, apple cores, coffee grounds, nutshells)
- Paper towels, napkins, facial tissues
- Disposable diapers & baby wipes
- Wash rags, cloth, clothing
- Kitty litter, aquarium gravel, bedding material for animals such as hamsters
- Pet waste & pet waste bags
- Plastic (of any kind)
- Cotton swabs and balls, bandages
- Dental floss
- Chewing gum
- Cosmetics
- Pets (goldfish, hamsters, gerbils)
- Hair
- Syringes
- Poisons & hazardous waste

Most of these listed items can be discarded in the trash, though there are some that have more specific disposal methods. For information regarding disposal and recycling options of the materials listed, call 350-6760.

PAYMENT & FEES

- The following are accepted as a form of registration payment: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Check or Money Orders. For security purposes, identification will be asked to be provided for credit cards and check payments.
- All fees, times and dates of all programs are subject to change.
- An additional \$12 non-resident fee applies per participant, per class, per activity or membership. A non-resident is anyone living outside the incorporated boundaries of the City of Fontana.
