“Go Green, Save Green”

- Set your thermostat to 78 degrees or higher, use fans and close window coverings during the day.
- Aggressive driving such as speeding up and slowing down and weaving in and out of traffic can lower fuel efficiency by 33 percent. Accelerate gently and stay with the traffic to save gas and money
- Don't go shopping without a list! According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, people waste about 30 percent of their household food budgets buying groceries that eventually expire and have to be thrown out. Know what you want to buy before you hit the store aisles—you'll buy less of what you don't need, buy more of what you're likely to use, and reduce the impact your shopping has on the planet.
- Don't leave the lights on when you leave the room. You could save as much as \$100 per year in electricity costs by turning off a 100-watt light bulb when you're not using the light.
- Don't leave the computer on if you're going to be gone longer than two hours, and don't leave the monitor on if you're going to be gone longer than 20 minutes. If you plug your electronics into an energy-saving power strip, you can reduce the energy they use by as much as 40 percent.
- Don't leave the water running when you brush your teeth. Turning off the tap when you brush your teeth can save up to 8 gallons of water a day, 240 gallons a month – saving hundreds on your water bill each year.
- Don't buy new. Remember the 3 R's of eco-friendly living? They begin with “reduce” (the other two are “re-use” and “recycle”). If you need to shop, start with eBay, Freecycle.org, the neighbor's yard sale, or the thrift store.
- Don't sit at your computer all day. Get outdoors for at least an hour to remember why Mother Nature is worth protecting.
