Paper Milk Cartons
Paper Tubes
Phone Books
Plastic Bottles #1
Plastic Bottles #2
Plastic Laundry Detergent Bottles
Plastic Milk/Water Jugs
Tin Cans (Soup, Tuna, etc.)
Tissue Boxes
Wrapping Paper

Note: In general, all clean, dry papers and cardboard can be recycled. Bottles, cans and milk cartons must be empty. Food cans should be rinsed.
