Questions and Concerns of the Residents of Area 4:

Can someone attach a bike to a shopping cart, like one from Stater Bros?

Lt. Koval advised no they cannot because that would be considered stealing of the shopping cart.

When is the city going to pour concrete in the area where the pipe busted last year on Citrus and Kerte?

Monique with Engineering advised she will check on it.

Just moved to the area and there are a lot of speeders from about 9pm to 1am. Advised she lives on Mt. View and the speeders are Mulberry to Jurupa, are the police officers not enforcing the speeding laws?

We do have officers who enforce speeding laws, if you have times and locations please let us know and we can let our traffic officers know where to focus.

With all the mailbox thefts happening in the city, are the mailboxes that are being targeted unsecured?

Most of the mailbox thefts are from the locked community mailboxes.

There are speeders on Cherry from Jurupa to Mulberry from about 9am to 1pm as well.

Officer Mundrick took a note of it to let our traffic officers know.

Is it expensive to install speed bumps?

The city has a policy not to install them because it slows emergency personnel and in studies it shows speed bumps do not help with speeders.

There is a problem on Village. The whole street is filled with cars because of the apartment complex.

Lauren Popescu with Traffic Engineering advised he will check into it to see if the street is too small for parking on both sides of the street, if it is then we can put up no parking signs and the officers can start to enforce that.

At Country Village Park there is lots of traffic coming and going, thinks it is suspicious.

Lt. Kraut advised sometime with recent reports it could be people playing that Pokemon Go game; however, if you feel anything is suspicious you can contact our dispatch to have an officer check it out.

There are big rig trucks going over sierra where it says no trucks. They are usually seen going south on Sierra during the week going towards the 60 freeway.

What can be done with cannabis second hand smoke with your neighbors?

You can call dispatch and have an officer go out to advise the neighbors.

People are parking boats on the street, can anything be done about that?

If it is parked on the street they will need to have a permit. It can only be there for 72 hours.

A lot of parents do not want to let their children play at the park because people are using cannabis there.

If anyone is using drugs at the park, you can call our dispatch to send an officer out to handle the situation.
