BICYCLE PERMIT

Students who are in grades 4th and 5th are allowed to use bicycles for home to school transportation with the written permission of their parents. The use of bicycles at school requires observance of the rules listed below to ensure the safety of students and staff.

State law requires that students wear bicycle helmets.

Parents should be aware that the school is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged bicycles. If you desire your child to have permission for the use of his/her bicycle for home to school transportation, please read and discuss the rules below and sign this form indicating your consent.

1. I will follow traffic rules in riding my bicycle to and from school. In doing so, I will ride safely and in single file when riding with others.
2. I will walk my bicycle on campus at all times.
3. I will store my bicycle in the rack and secure it with a lock.
4. I will wear a helmet at all times, when riding my bicycle.

Violation of these rules will result in a warning and not being able to ride your bike to school or participate in future activities.
