PROTECT YOUR HOME & ENVIRONMENT

Think before flushing! Toilets and sewer systems are designed to transport and dispose of three things: water, toilet paper, and human waste. Recently, the prime culprits in clogging sewer systems have been "flushable" products. Contrary to their name, these products should not be flushed.

Items that should never be flushed:

- "Flushable items" (wipes, toilet bowl scrub pads, disposable mops, diapers)
- Tampons, tampon applicators, sanitary napkins, condoms
- Kitty litter, aquarium gravel, bedding material for animals such as hamsters
- Food items (bones, apple cores, coffee grounds, nutshells)
- Medications, vitamins & supplements
- Fats, oils & grease
- Paper towels, napkins, facial tissues
- Disposable diapers & baby wipes
- Wash rags, cloth, clothing
- Pet waste & pet waste bags
- Plastic (of any kind)
- Cotton swabs and balls, bandages
- Dental floss
- Chewing gum
- Cosmetics
- Pets (goldfish, hamsters, gerbils)
- Hair
- Syringes
- Poisons & hazardous waste

Most of these listed items can be discarded in the trash, though there are some that have more specific disposal methods. For information regarding disposal and recycling options of the materials listed, call 350-6760.

Firefighters train hard and make countless preparations to be ready for a wildfire. Residents need to do the same. Successfully preparing for a wildfire requires you to take personal responsibility for protecting yourself, your family, and your property.

We have published this Ready, Set, Go! Personal Wildfire Action Plan to give you the tips and tools to successfully prepare for a wildfire. It will give you guidance on retrofitting your home with fire-resistant features. It will help you create the necessary defensible space around your home. This publication will help you prepare your home, yourself, and your family so that you can leave early, well ahead of a fast-approaching wildfire.

It’s not a question of if, but when, the next wildfire will occur. With advance planning and preparation, you can dramatically increase your safety and the survivability of your property.

Being prepared for a wildfire or other fire disaster starts with making a plan. That’s why the San Bernardino County Office of Emergency Services created the ‘Ready SB’ app. Download the Ready SB app (<http://readydl.com/landing/eoc06071/index.html>) today and it will guide you step-by-step in creating your customized family disaster plan.

During a disaster, use Ready SB to receive emergency alerts, evacuation and shelter information, live up-to-date traffic reports, contact information of nearby resources, and everything you need to know to stay safe before, during, and after a disaster.

CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING IN YOUR HOME

Safety Tips

- Install CO alarms outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home including the basement. The CO alarm can warn you if too much CO is in your home.
- Keep CO alarms clear of dust and debris.
- Ensure CO alarms are plugged all the way into a working outlet, or if battery operated, have working batteries.

FIRE EXPLORER

The Fire Explorer program gives youth (ages 14-20) a first hand experience in what it mentally and physically takes to be a professional firefighter. Participants will receive fire service training under supervision of trained firefighters. The program is designed to give participants beneficial experience, discipline, and knowledge that can apply to any career field. To join, contact the Division Headquarters nearest you.




