- Kitty litter, aquarium gravel, bedding material for animals such as hamsters
- Food items (bones, apple cores, coffee grounds, nutshells)
- Medications, vitamins & supplements

- Paper towels, napkins, facial tissues
- Disposable diapers & baby wipes
- Wash rags, cloth, clothing
- Pet waste & pet waste bags
- Plastic (of any kind)







- If you are unable to attend or are not satisfied with a class, you may transfer to another class (if space is available), request credit for future Community Services Department program or request a refund. Requests for transfers and refunds must be made prior to the second class meeting.
- Please allow 4-6 weeks processing for all refunds.
- Approved refunds are subject to an administrative fee of \$10 per participant, per activity, per membership, per facility reservation.
- Material fees paid to the instructor are non-refundable.
- Credit card transactions will be refunded back to the original credit card.

## MINIMUM & MAXIMUM ENROLLMENT

Classes will be cancelled or combined if they do not have the minimum amount of registered participants. Classes with full capacity registration will begin placing interested participants on a waiting list. When and if openings occur, participants will be contacted and registration will take place on a first come, first serve basis. 
