## Family Reading - My Hero is You

“My Hero is You” explains how children can protect themselves, their families and friends from coronavirus and how to manage difficult emotions when confronted with a new and rapidly changing reality.

### Materials:

- My Hero is You pdf book

### Ask Questions:

- *Before reading:* Looking at the cover, what do you think this book will be about? What makes you think that? What genre is this book? How do you know? What’s the setting of this story?
- *While reading:* What is happening in the story so far? What do you think will happen next? What makes you say that? What problems/challenges are the characters facing?
- *After reading:* What was the author’s purpose? Was he/she trying to persuade, inform or entertain you? What was the turning point? How did the character/s change during the story? What were the most important parts of the story? Did you like the way the story ended? What did you like about it? What are you still wondering about?

### Reflection take away:

This wonderful book helps children understand and navigate this new landscape and learn how they can take small actions to become the heroes in their own stories to stay positive and safe.
