The Great Seal

The great seal of the state of California was adopted at the California state constitutional convention of 1849 and has undergone minor design changes. This activity will allow students to symbolize what their country means to them and understand what the seal symbolizes in their state and what it stands for. This creative activity can allow students to think of the present moment and focus their imagination to design their own great seal and symbolize what their state means to them.

Materials:

- Card stock
- Pencil
- Markers
- Colored pencils
- Crayons

Instructions:

1. Take the card stock and cut it into a round shape.
2. Use a variety of color pencils to symbolize the great seal
3. Create what their great state of California means to you.



Modification:

Students can use any color construction paper if cardstock is unavailable. Use glitter or glue glitter for an added touch to creative designs.
