EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION NO. 2020-06

EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY MANAGER/
DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES OF THE CITY OF
FONTANA, CALIFORNIA, PROCLAIMING THE LIFTING OF
THE CURFEW CURRENTLY IN EFFECT IN THE CITY OF
FONTANA

SECTION 1. RECITALS

- A. On June 5, 2020, due to anticipated protests and out of an abundance of caution to ensure concerned individuals could safely exercise their First Amendment rights to expressive activity and assembly, while at the same time public safety officials could take reasonable and necessary steps to ensure the safety and protection of life and property in the City, acting as the City's Director of Emergency Services, I signed Proclamation No. 2020-05, declaring the continued existence of an emergency in the City and instituting a curfew between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and sunrise of the following day.
- B. The conditions that warranted the adoption of that proclamation and the institution of the curfew no longer exist within the City.
- C. This Proclamation and Order is adopted pursuant to the City's police powers and powers afforded to the City in time of local emergency, such powers being afforded by the State Constitution, State law, and the Fontana Municipal Code to protect the peace, health, and safety of the public, and to protect life and property as affected by the emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mark R. Denny, Director of Emergency Services for the City of Fontana, do hereby issue the following order to become effective immediately, subject to ratification within seven days by the City Council:

IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED THAT:

SECTION 2. This Proclamation 2020-06 supersedes and repeals Proclamation 2020-05, issued at or about 4:00 p.m. on June 5, 2020.

SECTION 3. There is no longer any local curfew in effect within the City of Fontana.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any provision of this Proclamation or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Proclamation are declared to be severable.
